
Dear Mr. Thomas:

We are very appreciative of your reception report of our KNBC Transmitter. We have not been receiving much eastern mail within the past few years since so many other transmitters are assigned our operating frequency: It is a rare occasion indeed and only when our signal is the only one on 680 kilocycles.

We still receive mail from Australia, New Zealand, and Alaska, which is beyond the transmitter range of other continental stations.

To answer your question, I do not personally remember a listeners' report of auto reception from so far east. Again, thank you for your report.
