This will verify your report of reception of our test on the morning of March 1, 1950, between 12:30 and 1:28 AM, P.S.T. Many thanks for your report.


Equipment here consists of a Collins 212B-2 Console, Collins 26W Limiting Amplifier, Collins 20T 1 KW Transmitter, and a 285 foot Wincharger Guyed Vertical Radiator.

We are located in the bottom land of the Kings River, approximately $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles northeast of Sanger and 17 miles east of Fresno. Fresno is the world's largest producer of raisins and sweet wines, while Sanger is known as the "Nation's Christmas Tree City" due to the annual festival centered around the General Grant Tree.

We are located at the western edge of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. No doubt the proximity of this range of mountains, which contains a number of peaks over 14,000 feet high, prevents us from laying a stronger signal in your direction.
