
Dear David:

The program described in your report of February 7th. was broadcast from this station on the morning of February 7th., and was our regular February frequency check. Thanks a million for your report.

Here is a little dope on our station----
Transmitter and studios are located at 2800 Main avenue. Use a series-fed 180' vertical antenna, kicking out about 250 watts. Doing the kicking is an all "Gates" transmitter using high-level modulation with a couple of 805's as finals and a couple more for modulators. We also employ a "Gates" peak-limiting amplifier.

Durango is in the heart of the San Juan Basin, the last of the "Old West". I'm enclosing a folder on our fair city. How about putting Durango on your list of "PLACES I WANT TO SEE BEFORE I DIE". And when you make that trip be sure to drop in at K I U P and see
