Dear DX'er:

This is to verify reception of KREX Radio between 1:00 and 2:00 AM (MST) Monday, March 4, 1957.

KREX Radio was on the air between 1:00 and 2:00 AM (MST) Monday, March 4, 1957 at the request of the National Radio Club, Special Programs Committee. They asked that we conduct the special DX test broadcast so that DX'ers could get verifications from KREX since we changed our call letters last May 1, from KFXJ Radio.

KREX Radio has two Gates AM transmitters. One is a 5000 Watt transmitter used from 5:45 AM (sign-on) until local sunset. The other is a 500 Watt transmitter which is used from local sunset until 12:00 M (sign-off). The antenna is 343 feet high. Most of KREX's Studio equipment is Gates, with Ampex and Magnecord tape recorders.

I hope that this is satisfactory verification of the broadcast, also, I would very much like to hear from you again in the future. It is quite possible that we might do another of these broadcasts sometime in the future.
