Thank you very much for your detailed reception report. We are glad to hear that Radio Moscow reception is good in your area.

As for your question regarding the two frequencies - 629 kcs and 785 kcs., we want to inform you that Radio Moscow broadcasts to North Korea and the Chinese People's Republic on 629kcs at the time you mentioned. The other frequency - 785 kcs is not used by any Soviet stations. You probably heard Pyongyang itself, which has its own broadcast at that time.
