Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thanks for your letter reporting reception of WBJW between 9 and 10:31 AM EDT. Program details in your letter agree with station programming for last Monday.

WBJW operates with a power of 5 Kilowatts non-directional from sunrise to sunset (7:30 AM to 7:30 PM EDT in March) and with 1 Kilowatt into a directional antenna system with major lobe to the east at night. WBJW signs off between 1 AM and 5 AM EDT each day.

Special code and voice ID's were used between midnight and 1 AM EDT on March 17, however your location on the back side of our directional antenna probably accounts for your not getting the special test transmissions. Most of our reports of DX reception at night are from eastern seaboard and New England states.

Thanks again for your interest in radio and WBJW.
