
Thanks for your call Monday Morning, January 30, 1978, and your report. I can positively confirm that you heard my test January 30, 1978 at 4:33 AM EST.

For a little technical info, WKEM uses a RCA BTA-1R 1000/250 watt transmitter. Our antenna is a 140' steel tower series fed at the base. We do not operate at full transmitter power since we are close spaced with stations in the Miami Area, and TRL up in Bradenton. Because of this I have to operate the transmitter at 736 watts during the day, and 192 watts at night. During the test, I was running day power; and I am a little suprized that I could be heard so well in Tampa.

We run country music during our broadcast day, and carry news from the Mutual Network. Every night at 9-10 PM we have an hour of Mexican-American music for our Spanish listeners.

Thanks for tuning in the test. If you are ever down here in these parts, stop by for the nickel tour.
