
Thank you very much for the report on our signal in central Florida. This is the first report of this kind received at this station. You have the call letters right, and you were definitely hearing us with your reports on the program. We went on the air on the 13 July. In case your interested Our frequency measurement are made on the third tuesday of each month at 4:00 am with Van Nostrand of Atlanta.

The transmitter here is a Gates 250C-1 and we run 250 watts in to a vertical antenna 150 feet high located in corner of a marsh. The console is home made. We have had very good reports in the daytime and can be heard fairly good for about a radius of 40 miles. The antenna resistance is very low, 16.6 ohms.

In case your interested I am also employed as maintenance engineer for WGGG during the school year in Gainesville, a 250 watter too.

Glad to hear from you David and looking forward to hearing from you again.
