Enclosed is a coverage map for normal operation which is from sunrise to sunset.

Transmissions are made the first Sunday in each month from about 5;05 a.m. until 5;55 a.m. for frequency measurement unless otherwise notified by the Atlanta monitoring station for another date. During winter months the equipment test reports were received as far as Calif. Colo. Minn. Mass. Toronto and many other states within the above radius. Quite a number of Ohio reports are received each month during cold weather.

I am unable to determine where QRM sets in from WSWN however listeners at Tampa confirmed ^{WMOP} programs.
