Dear Mr. Thomas:

Your letter of January 7, 1970 I find very interesting. I have not received communication referring to radio signal in that area before your letter. Several times I have received reception notices from the state of Pennsylvania and that immediate area, one other time from the state of California at sign on, 5:30 in the morning. Our frequency check is in Birmingham, Alabama at 0200 each third Wednesday.

We as radio do not plan anything for the eclipse March 7. Although our Chamber of Commerce and Development Authority have included in their plans reservations for all concerned. At this time reservations are made in Perry for people in all parts of the world and I am sure you could find a place to set up, but reservations would be limited.

Sorry I do not have coverage map available at this time as I am temporarily out. My master range coverage is 32 to 35 miles, audible reception. If you plan to be in Perry at the time of the eclipse I will be happy to work with you in any way and my engineer has expressed his desire to work with you also.
