Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you very much for your conformation.

The check you picked up was not our regular frequency check. It was quite accidental. Our regular check is the third Friday of each month if it isn't changed. I have quite a few right now while I try to get rid of some of the haywire.

On the morning of the 21 st. after getting some paper work cleaned up after sign off, I decided to beat my monitor against the network line 1000 cycle note. This showed 26 cycles plus and me a little plus with it. So I phoned Van Nostrand at Atlanta and found she was on O.

But I did learn that there was almost 50% carrier shift at 85 modulation. After a couple hours of sweting it out a piece of solder fell out of the 3 rd buffer. The voice was that of a new announcer.

This is a 250 watt composit transmitter. Os. 802, buf. 45,802,814. and 805 final's 150' windcharger ant. large ground system in sand and very poor ground wave.
