
We are in receipt of your report of reception of our station WTWB on October 30, 1972 and wish to advise that your report is correct.

In answer to your question about our transmission after 1 a.m., we had a transmitter failure. We managed to get back on the air about 1:45 a.m.

As you know WTWB operates on 1570kHz with 5000 Watts of power, daytime only. All of our equipment is of Gates Harris-Intertype manufacture. Programming on WTWB is gospel and country. Our transmitter is located North of Auburndale on the Dixie Highway.

We appreciate you taking time to write us, and are very glad to hear you listen to us.
