Thank you for your letter received yesterday. I would be most interested in confirming your account in your files in Ohio. If it is not too much to ask of you, when you return to your home, would you mail me your report?

Your Tampa report is accurate. As for interfering stations, you are right. One Lake Wales station is on our list as well as a station in Baton Rouge. Our directional is such to protect them. Any others I am not sure of, however, there are several in the vicinity that are over-modulating and spluttering all over the dial, this of course would also cause us some interference. Generally speaking though, I believe our signal is better than it ever has been. As time goes on, I will be trying again to gain better coverage. I appreciate the letters as it helps me to establish just how far-out we are reaching and how strong within and without our immediate area. Thus I can make minor adjustments to compensate for any lacks that I feel are present.

YOU ALSO enclosed a sheet that was in your paper. I feel in all fairness I should correct an error. When I came to WYND we were 162 degrees out of phase, not 60 degrees. So you can well see that most of our signal at that time was going directly into the Gulf of Mexico. Also I might add that from now on I will be (trying) to make regular maintenance checks on the last Saturday night of each month.
