Thank you for your letter detailing your reception of WPEH (AM) on 16 December 1974.

This letter will verify your reception of WPEH (AM), on 16 December 1974, at 0400 EST.

WPEH Radio was on the air that morning conducting our annual proof of performance, and the tones were used during the procedures involved in running a proof on a broadcast station.

WPEH (AM) is a 1 KW daytime station, using a Gates BC-1T transmitter, feeding a 200 foot tower, as the radiator. WPEH-FM operates with 3 KW ERP, using a Gates FM2H3 transmitter, and a four bay circular polarized antenna, sidemounted on the AM tower. Programming is simulcast during the AM broadcast day, and the FM continues operations until midnight each day.

Incidentally, I also received reception reports from Nebraska and Illinois, for that morning's operations.

Once again, thanks for your report, and I am glad to verify your reception of WPEH (AM).
