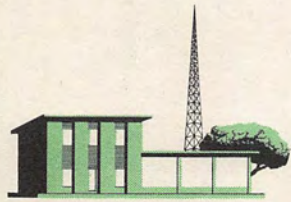

By special arrangement, KXLA, Los Angeles, is silent during this period so that the RCA people can check our frequency. KXLA should not bother you in the East, as they operate on the West Coast with the directional protecting WBT in Charlotte, North Carolina.
