KORL RADIO at 3 AM, EST on 7 Dec 1964.

KORL utilizes the following equipment - Gates  
BC-10P transmitter, operated at 10,000 watts. Antenna  
is a 330 ft series excited vertical radiator with the  
ground system extending into the banks of the Ala Wai  
Canal. Studios are located in the Waikiki Biltmore  
Hotel in the heart of Waikiki, the well-known resort  
section of Honolulu.

KORL completely covers the Hawaiian Islands and  
is the most powerful station in Hawaii. We have regular  
listeners on Midway, in Alaska and Samoa and regularly  
receive reception reports from Australia and New Zealand.
