Dear Sir;

Thanking you very much for your letter of the 29th. I am always glad to hear from any DX'ers. Also glad to verify your reception reports. I am certainly suprised that you could receive us that far from Paris.

We operate on 1440 kcs. with a power of 500 watts. We have a Gates BC-500-D xmitter coupled by means of shunt feeding to 200 ft. Wincharger type tower. We use Gates audio almost exclusively in our operation which is combined and located about 2 miles west of Paris on Rt #133.

One of our announcers is from Zanesville, Ohio and he didn't think it was ever possible to hear us over there. I don't suppose his father has a receiver like yours or even an outside antenna. We are going to conduct our next frequency check at 12:25 to 12:40 AM on the 6th of this month. You might be able to hear us good then.
