Dear Mr. Thomas:

We received your letter of March 2 and was glad to receive the enclosed information. A field check on car FM is of great interest and we were very satisfied with the results that you submitted.

As you probably know, KANU, is owned and operated by the University of Kansas. We have a Western Electric Transmitter, 506 B-2 which runs 10 KW output and a Western Electric Clover Leaf antenna which has a gain of 3.5 giving us approximately 35 KW ERP. The tower which is 510 ft. is situated on a hill which helps to give us greater coverage.

Your information on FM stations operating independently of AM stations being a greater success was interesting. Since the University does not have an AM station, this problem does not arise. KANU, which is non-commercial is operated primarily for educational purposes and carries a large variety of programs.

We are happy to confirm your mobil reception of KANU on June 24, 1956.
