Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you for your report on reception of Radio Station WMTC on Sunday, March 13th, 1955. From your report there is no doubt that you were listening to this station. This letter will serve as a verification of your reception.

WMTC, as you will see from this letter head, is owned by the Kentucky Mountain Holiness Association, an inter-denominational religious organization. About twenty different denominations of churches are working together in this Association. The Association maintains this radio station, three grade schools, one high school, about twenty-five local churches, and some other smaller units of work.

All of us who are directly connected with WMTC live here in the Vancleve community - not in Jackson.

You will be more than welcome at any time to visit us here at either the transmitter or studios. They are about a quarter of a mile apart.

We do have a quite limited schedule on Sundays. Our staff is too small to keep more on the air of the quality we want. Consequently we do not begin Sunday broadcasting until noon.
