Dear Dave:-

Radio Station WCRB wishes to verify your report of reception dated February 19, 1951 of our special equipment test program held in co-operation with and dedicated to the NATIONAL RADIO CLUB and the NEWARK NEWS RADIO CLUB as correct.

The equipment used by this station is almost entirely of Raytheon mfg., the X'mtr being the RA-1000, operation at an output of 1000 watts, using a pair of 833A's in the final and a pair of 833A's in modulator. The antenna is a single non-directional vertical radiator 203 feet in height and used in conjunction with a ground system consisting of 170 buried copper wire radials each approx. 200 feet in length.

Our normal operating day is from 6:30 AM EST week-days, 8:00 AM EST on Sundays to local sunset. 5:15 PM, EST this month. 5:45 PM next.
