We are very proud of our Station, as all details were carefully planned to obtain the ultimate in F.M. Broadcasting. We have no A.M.

Our Transmitter is an R.E.L. (Armstrong System) 250 watt driver and 3KW final, looking into a 3 inch copper coax at 88% and feeding an 8 bay turnstile with a gain of 7.6 developing 20KW ERP.


Our antenna sub-structure is a Blaw Knox 400 ft. 680 ft. above sea level.
