KICK is Mutual for this region, and uses UP news and the Standard program library. We operate from 6:30 to 1:00 am, CST, daily; Saturdays--6:30 to 2:00 am; Sundays--7:00 to 1:00 am. Our regular monthly FC is with Kansas City (Commercial Radio) on the 4th Wednesday from 1:20 to 1:35 am, CST.

We would appreciate a report from you at anytime you might receive our station. Your report is the most complete in regards to reception conditions, and very informative.

We hope that this letter will suffice as verification, and that the enclosed snap-photo of our building and tower will be of interest to you.
