Dear David,

I am pleased to confirm your reception of KOKO radio on 1450 KHz. at 2:25 A.M., CDT, on Monday, January 21, 1974. Your report was of the same CW ID heard in Pennsylvania by Kermit Geary. Tom Sundstrom in New Jersey got an earlier CW ID. Your three reports, along with a tape containing very surprising audio from Daryl Belanger in Swan River, Manitoba were the most distant. As best I can figure you all are about 1,000 miles from here, and it's impossible to figure exactly.

In all, we got 23 reports from 12 states and Manitoba. The most came from Illinois (5), followed by four from Nebraska, three from Indiana, and two from Ohio. Single reports in addition to the previously mentioned ones, came from Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Minnesota, and Missouri. We were very well pleased with the results and would have had many more reports if any others had been listening in the areas north and south of here. Paul Hart sent a beautiful tape from Fort Worth.

We were quite excited to get your report, as it came in before the other most distant ones. Sorry for the delay, but I wanted to send personal letters to each reporter, and also I'm waiting on the printers to finish some QSL cards.
