WBKH has been on the air since September 1, 1954 with our assigned 1000 watts. We applied to the FCC for 5kw yesterday on our present frequency, daytime only.

WBKH signs on each morning Monday thru Sunday at 5 a.m., and leaves the air at local sundown.


We have recently installed insulators on our tower which accounts for the fact that we are received at great distances in the early morning hours.
