
Thank you for your reception report of January 28, 1963 from 5:12 AMEST to 5:35 AMEST. Our station signed on a little late that morning. As a rule we are on from 4:00 AM CST till local sundown, 1590 kcs, 5,000 watts from a 155 foot tower.

WOKJ began operation around 1954 with one kilowatt. It now has a CP for one kilowatt at night, and a three-inline-array. However, this Company has also a 50 kw station under construction here for 1550 kcs, six towers in line at night, and five of them for the daytime array. They will have to dispose of WOKJ before a license will be granted the new station (WJAQ).

We hope to start directional proofs in March, weather permitting.
