We have a great pleasure of verifying as correct and exact your nice report of our last special program broadcasted on January 3rd, at the early morning. We congratulate you for the carefully attention you paid in order to obtain the precise details that you have given to this station in your attentive letter.


Please continue listening to our station and invite your friends to report its programs in such a way as you did. We are very glad when we receive communications from DXfans at distant points asking for verifications of their receptions. We always verify them when they are correct.

Our regular schedule is as follows: from 12M to 3 P.M. and from 7 to 10 P.M. at working days; on Sundays, from 9 to 11 A.M. and from 1 to 3 P.M. Now we have regulated our special midnight programs broadcasting them at 1.30 to 4.00 on Sunday mornings. (All in Havana time).

We broadcast on 1,285 kilocycles with 150 watts of power and a wave length of 233.4 meters.
