My Dear Friend Mr. Thomas:

I have just received your post card of Dec. 17th. I see you spent the entire hour from 5 to 6 a.m. E.S.T. tuning in the 1160 Kcs. channel trying to hear our Station. I appreciate very much your interest in tuning us and I am surprised to know that you could not hear C.M.H.J. clearly as we have received many reports stating every detail of our DX Program corresponding to that hour (our best DXing over C.M.H.J. this season I suppose). May be your local conditions were very bad that morning and that is the only reason I can find.

It is with deep regret that I receive your post card to-day, after the morning you had selected for our dual DXing and checking of stations over the entire Broadcast Band. Of course we can choose another Thursday, for instance: Thursday morning Dec. 31 and Thursday morning Jan. 7. I will be DXing Dec. 31 from 2 to 4 a.m. EST; and will do the same thing Jan. 7 from 3.30 to 4.30 after our DX Program that morning which I hope you will get and report. Please let me know if this is O.K. with you, unless sickness and severe interference, of course.

I will specially dedicate those minutes and seconds of DXing in logging Spanish speaking stations to help you in case of some doubt.

I am very glad to tell you that I am almost sure that that you heard our fine C.M.H.J. the morning of Thursday Dec; 17. The selection heard: "Indian Love Call" was played at the same time you state in your post card and that detail will entitle you to the right to possess one of our Photo-veri, just like the one appearing in the January Number of All Wave Radio Magazine in the article written by Mr. Ray La Rocque, our dear friend from Worcester, Mass.

As every verification granted is thoroughly revised by the owners of this Station C.M.H.J. I advise you to write me a letter stating the time and number you heard: the selection Indian Love Call the morning of Dec. 17., including 4 stamps of 4 cents (U.S.A. Stamps), and I will be more than glad to send you the verification card you really deserve. This, by no means, is a verification, as you have to fulfill those requirements.
