Dear Mr. Thomas,

Many thanks for your kind letter of April 17th and I can assure you, we are pleased to learn that you receive our signal so far afield.

I confirm that it was Radio Dominica you heard and the other details you require are as follows:

We got on the air on November 1st 1971 with 10,000 watts of power broadcasting on 590 Khz. In December of 1972 we switched to 595 to avoid some interference from Cuban and Venezuelan stations. We still have the 500 watts transmitter at the Stock Farm which we use as a standby.

Our new transmitter is located at Hillsborough (don't know if you visited there) and we broadcast in three segments:

6.00 a.m. - 10.00 a.m.

12.00 noon - 2.00 p.m.

5.00 p.m. - 10.30 p.m.

The station is owned by the Government of Dominica and is operated as a division of the Civil Service.

I am happy to learn you have such fine recollections of Dominica and I do hope you visit us someday again. Alot has changed, but basically it is still all there, unspoilt by tourism.

Once again thanks for your comments.
