I try answer your questions :

XEN-FM has two months on the air, now has only two Andrew bays on the antenna, we shall put on it 6 bays, because - this reason we are received only reports of México City.

XEN-AM has on the air 30 years, and has 5 kws. Twelve years ago, the equipment were made by my - father, now we are constructing a new equipment for XEN - 20 kws, and we shall change the plant adress, now is in - University Ave, the new direction of the plant are in -- Ixtapalapa Distrito Federal.

The FM is not yet very popular, because the more of the F M stations are used like Links, other are used like links (but not Plant AM studios like us, Radio Mil etc.) on the republic, XEW and XEQ has two FM stations each one, one for the link studios - Am plant, and the other for the link to the plants repiting, on - the republic. These are AM stations in: Monterrey, San Luis Potosi, Veracruz etc. *The FM Transmitter is located on the*

Another FM station (XHFM) had been --- working on 94.9 megacilos, but with the Sismic movement (july 28) the building and the antenna of the XHFM was - dislocated, the building will be destroyed.
