I thank you for your letter dated 31st May and for the interesting information regarding the reception of this station in the Islands of the Caribbean.


I am very sorry you did not manage to pay us a visit during your stay in St. Lucia, but I hope that if you return you will set aside an hour of your time to give us a call.

Radio Caribbean is an International Station broadcasting 14 hours a day in French and 3 hours a day in English. Our Transmitter is a Collins 10 Kw. We cover mainly the Windward and Leeward Islands and also Barbados and Trinidad. In addition of course we are well received in the French Islands Martinique, Guadeloupe and French Guyane.

Our aerial is situated at Vigie Point i.e. West of the airport. The aeriels you mention at Morne Fortune, south of the town belong to the old Cable & Wireless station but are no longer used.
