Dear Mr. Thomas:



The equipment here is Gates delux all the way through with the exception of Presto turntables, Shure dynamic mikes and a quarter wave windcharger antenna.

Your report is the farthestest daytime reception check we have had to date, and, in my opinion, is very unusual. Should you hear us again, I will appreciate another report as they are very helpful.
