William D. (Bill) Smith, announcer on duty during your reception period, confirms, in part at least, your notation regarding reception of fine concert music during which interval Massenet's "Elegy" was broadcast.

We radiate approximately thirty eight thousand watts from a Western Electric Seven section Cloverleaf antenna, 268 feet above ground or around 1150 feet above sea level. The terrain in this area is relatively flat which gives us good coverage until hills and mountains intervene.
