This is to verify your Reception Report of December 26th. Please excuse our delay in replying. We are pleased to say that the information you submitted checked completely with our program log.

Our frequency changed to 1110 October 7, 1944. It may be of interest to you to know that we are going to increase our power to 50,000 watts, and our transmitter construction for our expanded facilities is pretty well under way. We hope to have the project completed sometime next fall.
