Dear Mr. Thomas:-

This is to acknowledge and thank you for your report of reception from this station. Both of your cards received and very much appreciated by the operators at this station. The operator's name at the time you were listening was L.T. Nutterfield. Our transmitter modulates 100% with approximately 70% on voice and 30% on range or side band. The power is 400W voice and 275W on the range. We have 4 125ft directional vertical antennae for the radio beam and a 5th tower in the center for the voice. This is a U.S. airway Communication station furnishing radio range and voice broadcasts of information valuable to pilots of aircraft. There is a station on the same order as this one at Columbus and Cincinnati, Ohio, if you would care to make a visit to one. They are located at major airports in the U.S.A. Thank you again for your report.
