Radio Station KTNC is located in Falls City, Nebraska - with studios in the Hotel Stephenson. Falls City has a population of 7,500 people, and is located in a rich agriculture area.

KTNC operates with a power of 100 watts on a frequency of 1230 Kcs. Hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., seven days a week. The transmitter is a Gates 250GY and the Antenna tower is 150 feet in height, guyed, and series fed.

Mr. Craig Siegfried also owns Radio Station KIMO in Independence, Missouri, with a power of 1000 watts on 1510 Kcs.
