This is to confirm your report on mobile reception of our signal, CBT, on July 6th, 1954.

As far as I am able to determine, the "talk on English Teaching in Schools" was the program "So to Speak" from Toronto, on the Trans-Canada Network, and broadcast from 9.15 pm to 9.30 pm Nfld. Daylight Time. That program was followed by "This is Radio" from Montreal, from 9.30 to 10.00 pm, during which program the selection "I've Got the World on a String" may have been played. The announcer/operator on duty here at the time does not remember details of the program. I presume you know that a Music Clearance Sheet which lists selections to be played, is made out only at the origination point of the program; in this case Montreal.

There seems little doubt, then, that you did receive us, so this is to verify your reception of our station.

We thank you for your report. The only observations made in this area were those of casual observers.
