Thank you very much for your letter with regard to the reception of radio station VOHF. It is always with pleasure that we receive word from DXers at distant (comparatively speaking) points.


VOHF operates on an assigned frequency of 1490 kilocycles daily from 0500 to 2200 (EST), or 0700 to 2400 Harmon Time. Our studios are located in the DeGinque Hotel at this Air Force Base.

The equipment used is a 32 RA Collins transmitter with a 50-watt output, and a 2535-AB Gates console.


