This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of Sept. 25th.

On Sunday morning, Sept. 25th., between 4 and 5 a.m. Nfld. D. S. T. which would be approximately 2.30 to 3.30 E. S. T., Station VONF broadcasted a special DX programme (not all Organ music). This programme was broadcasted at the request of a local member of ~~the~~<sup>a</sup> DX Club, and we do not expect to broadcast any other programmes of this sort for some time.

Station VONF operates on a frequency of 1115 kilocycles and has a capacity at present of approximately 200 watts which will be increased to 5,000 watts within the next few months.


The DX programme was heard in Vancouver, British Columbia, but so far we have had no absolute proof of its being heard in your vicinity.
