
Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you for your report on our all night program for October 19, 1953.
The information is accurate.

W C A M went full-time about three years ago - prior to that we operated only 28½ hour a week. We started twenty-four hour operation just nine weeks ago. Before we were full time we operated on 500 watts, however the F. C. C. would only approve us for 250 watts on an unlimited operation because of possible interference with a station in Trenton, N. J. which is not too far away from Camden.
