I wish to thank you for the informative report on both the AM and FM signals of WCTC.

I must apologize for the delay in answering you. I came across your letter today as I was looking through an old magazine. I apparently opened your letter and laid it down on the desk and then it must have found its way into the magazine.

I was particularly pleased with your report on WCTC-FM as we seldom get reports on it. I was surprised to hear that you did not hear other New Jersey FM stations. WTOA operates out of Trenton, New Jersey and WAAT-FM from Newark, New Jersey. However, at the time of your report I believe WAAT-FM was off the air due to transmitter trouble. I realize that WCTC-AM does not do too well at night. 1450 Kc is a community frequency with all 250 watt stations and it is usually a mess. Our FM frequency 98.3 Mc is also a community frequency we run 1 KW on FM.

Again thank you for your report of July 10 and 11 and I'm sorry for the delay in answering.
