

This is a very find report, and it is a pleasure to contact you once again, from a different place. I still have the very nice letter received from your father, I guess it was, who received KBNZ so well on his car radio, but you did not hear me at all, from there. I never did get around to answering it, even though I intended to.

Your log is quite accurate and definitely identifies the signals as ours. I was surprised to note we blocked XELO. Most others had trouble because of them. And everyone reported high noise level from local condx. Guess we should try again later in the season. I guess you know WCAM is one a different frequency now, and they also have a new xmtr location with a vertical antenna. They used to have a flat top when you verified. Then later they used the flat top merely for a support, and tuned the vertical lead. Maybe you should try them again, although I note you checked with them about QSB. Tnx for the nice report, and keep sending those fine forms around. I wish more people would take it so seriously.
