Using the tone CW method of frequency check leaves little doubt that the station logged was WCBA. I do appreciate the cards and letters that are sent to the station following each check as I am interested in seeing just what our signal will do. So far we have heard from California, the most distant point, Canada and a few southern states.

To me it seems like a strange that we can put out over WADC. Not that I am doubting your word one bit for we have had mail from Chicago stating that the signal was well above ADC's a 5000 watter.

You asked why no voice, well when we use to take the checks the QRM prevented RCA from making definite statements that it was our signal checked so they requested the tone - CW type check. I think in the future the sign on and off will be with voice but the contents of the check will have to remain the same.
