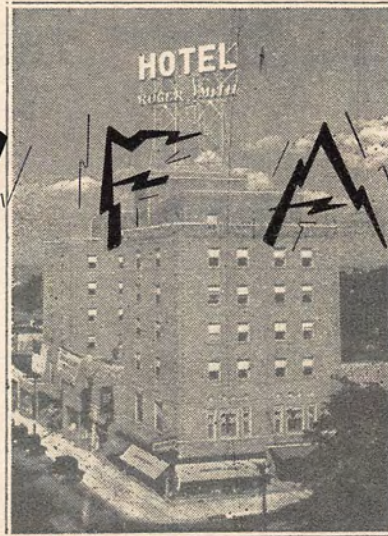

However, presumably better late than never, so here is your verification of reception on our program of above date. Your report tallies with our log.


Prize winners were: First prize (Fruit-Cake) to Mr. Harold Moser, Route 1, Troy, Kansas.
