
Dear Mr. Thomas:

We must require, however, in order to protect our own interests, that you duplicate, which very likely you have already done, the permissions granted under the American Society of Authors Composers, and Publishers License. If you are using any Western Electric material in your transmitting apparatus it would also be necessary, as a point of information, for you to hold a Western Electric license.

As practically every U. S. broadcasting station have taken care of these things, we know no reason why you could not re-transmit our signals.
