
Dear Dave:

Thanks for your report of reception of WXYJ on December 10, 1962 from 4:00 to 5:00 AM. WXYJ was on the air from 4:00 to 4:25 AM with 1000 cycle tone with station breaks every three minutes. From 4:25 to 4:30 there was code and an interview with Norm Pillsbury, who was in our studios during the program. From 4:30 to 5:00 AM there were band selections, which you said you could identify.

WXYJ operates from 5:30 AM to 1:05 AM weekdays, and from 7:55 AM to 12:05 AM Sundays, with 250 watts non-directional. The antenna is a 150 foot self supporting structure mounted on the roof of the WXYJ Building in downtown Jamestown.

I am glad that you were able to log WXYJ, although there was a lot of QRM. Thanks again for your report, and good luck in the future in your Radio Club activities.
