
Dear Mr. Thomas:

Your letter concerning reception of our stations has been received. Our sincere thanks for your kind interest, and as you requested, are sending a separate letter for each of the two forms you sent to us.

Concerning our FM station: We have 42K.W. - E.R.P., using an RCA BTF-10B -10K.W. transmitter. Our Antenna is atop one of our AM towers (of which we use four..which is the reason you do not receive our AM station.) The tower is 322 feet above ground and the site elevation is 936 feet above sea level.
