Thank you so much for your letter and report of the reception of WSUM during our special test on May 11, 1981. This letter should serve as a verification of reception of WSUM.

I'm sorry I did not get more information from you on the phone so I knew where you were at the time. I appreciated the call very much.

From the material in your letter, yes, we did make it to Florida since you did list several of the Code ID's at the correct time slot. In fact most of the reports we got would not have been possible if the code ID's were not broadcast since they seemed to cut through the mess that some had to listen to.

I operated the station with its directional antenna during the first 30 minutes of the test and then at 3:30 am switched to non-directional operation till 4:00 am. WSUM operates with 500 watts using a four tower directional antenna. The format is Religious as it is with our other 5 stations.
