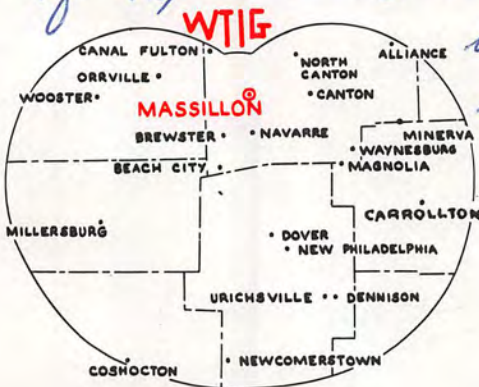

Dear Sir:

Thank you for sending your report of reception during the WTIG-NMRC test program. WTIG operates on a frequency of 990 KC with a directional antennae system, (3 towers) with a pattern in a southerly direction, see below. We use a Collins 300 B-2 transmitter with a Collins custom built cabinet. All 3 towers are 200 ft. high. Transmitter site is located 4.3 miles N.W. of Massillon, Ohio. Interference was reported in almost every report from station WCFB, WHOO, & WTRF.
