We were especially happy here at KWGS to get the report from you in regard to our signal strength.

I believe this is the first report from a mobile rig that we have had.

It is interesting to note that our signal compared favorably with WMBH-FM. He is 70,000 watts ERP whereas we are only radiating ~~4,000~~ 4,000 ERP from a 265' tower.

Our station here is student staffed with the exception of the manager and myself. We are off the air during the month of August. Beginning Sept. 1, we will be on from 5PM until 10:30 every day.

We have a western electric 1KW transmitter. It has the motor driven deal for frequency corrections with which you may be familiar. (A pain)

It would be a pleasure for us if you would visit us the next ~~in~~ time that you are in this part of the country. Again, thanks for your nice report. It was sure a morale builder to the students as well as myself.
