I am very pleased to hear that you heard our signal on 1450 kc. for a few minutes at 5:00 a.m. EST on December 7, 1952.

Since this was our first DX Special using our new transmitter, which has been in service since July 29, 1952, we have been especially interested in the results.

Our transmitter is an RCA BTA-250M, with a power output of 250 watts, feeding a single vertical quarter wave tower, against a buried radial counterpoise. Pattern is, of course, circular.

You will be interested to learn that the change of call letters was occasioned by a change of ownership. Present Managing Director is Mr. Jack R. Radford, hence the "JR".
